When referring to prayer, the word is usually capitalized ( "rosary", as is customary for other prayers names, such as "the Lord's Prayer," and "The Hail Mary"); When referring to pearls, it is written with a lower case initial letter of the event ( "a bead of the rosary"). The prayers of the rosary are arranged in sets of ten Hail Marys, called decades. Every decade is preceded by the prayer of the Lord ( "our father") and is traditionally followed by a Glory be. Many Catholics also choose to play the "O my Jesus" prayer after the glory be, which is the most known of the seven Fatima prayers. During the recitation of each set, the thought is given to one of the mysteries of the Rosary, which recalls the events in the life of Jesus and Mary. Five decades are recited for rosary. The rosary beads are a help to say these prayers in the proper sequence. Pope Pius V (in Office 1566 -1572) has established a standard 15 mysteries of the Rosary, based on a habit of long standing. What groups the mysteries in three sets: the joyful mysteries, the sorrowful mysteries and glorious mysteries. In 2002, Pope John Paul II said he is apt that was a new set of five, defined the Light Mysteries, bringing the total number of mysteries to 20. The glorious mysteries are prayed on Sunday and Wednesday, joyful on Monday and Saturday, back on Tuesday and and and the Luminous on Thursday. Usually five decades are recited in a session. For more than four centuries different popes have promoted the Rosary as part of the veneration of Mary in the Catholic Church.[5] and consisting essentially in meditation on the life of Christ.[6] The Rosary also represents the Catholic emphasis on "participation in the life of Mary, whose center was Christ", and the Mariological theme "to Christ for half of Mary".[7] Traditional Fifty Years Silver Rosary An Egyptian Coptic Rosary with an extra Coptic crucifix Devotions and Spirituality Main article: Devotions of the Rosary and Spirituality Devotion to the Rosary is one of the most important features of popular Catholic spirituality.[8] Pope John Paul II placed the Rosary He called it "among the most beautiful and praiseworthy traditions of Christian contemplation".[9][10][11] Catholics believe that the Rosary is a remedy against the trials, temptations, and difficulties of life, and that the Rosary is one of the great weapons given to believers in their struggle against [1] [2] Pope Pius XI says, for example, "The Rosary is a powerful weapon for casting out demons"[13]. Saints and Popes emphasized the meditative and contemplative elements of the Rosary and provided specific teachings on how to pray the Rosary, such as the need for "concentration, respect, reverence and purity of intention" during the recitation of the Rosary and contemplation [14]. From the 16th century onwards, the recitation of the Rosary often involved "figurative texts" that helped meditation. These images continue to be used to describe the mysteries of the Rosary. The Catholic saints stressed the importance of meditation and contemplation. Biblical meditations on the rosary are based on the Christian tradition of Lectio Divina, as a way of using the Gospel to initiate a dialogue between the person and Christ. Padre Pio, a devotee of the Rosary, said: "By studying books one seeks God; by meditation one finds him" [15] The references to the Rosary are part of a series of Marian apparitions that lasted two centuries. The messages conveyed by these apparitions have influenced the spread of devotion to the Rosary throughout the world.[16][17] In Quamquam pluries Pope Leo XIII linked the devotions of the Rosary to St. Joseph and granted indulgences on behalf of Christian believers who, in the month of October, would add the Prayer to St. Joseph at the end of the Holy Rosary.[18] Prayer of the Rosary can be prescribed by priests as a form of penance after confession. [20] According to the pious tradition, the concept of the Rosary was given to St. Dominic of Osma in an appearance of the Blessed Virgin Mary during the year 1214 in the church of Prouille, although in reality it was known from the 9th century in various forms. This Marian apparition received the title of Our Lady of the Rosary. [21] In the 15th century he was promoted by Alanus de Rupe (aka Alain de la Roche or Alan of the Rock), a Dominican priest and theologian, who established the "five promises of rosary" and began many rosary brotherhoods. According to Herbert Thurston, it is certain that during the 12th century and before Dominic's birth, the practice of acting 50 or 150 Ave Marias had become generally familiar. According to the 20th century editions of the Catholic Encyclopedia, the story of the devotion of Domenico al Rosario and the alleged appearance of the Madonna del Rosario does not appear in any document of the Catholic Church or of the Dominican Order before the writings of de Rupe, about 250 years after Dominic. [22] However, the recent scholarship of Donald H. Calloway, who received the approval of some of the church hierarchy, seeks to refute this claim. [23] Leonard Foley said that although Mary gives the Rosary to Dominic is recognized as a legend, the development of this form of prayer owes much to the Order of Preachers. [24] The practice of meditation during the prayer of the Hail Mary is attributed to Domenico di Prussia (1382-1460) a tattoo monk who called it "Vita di Gesù Rosario". [25] The German monk of Trier added a sentence to each of the 50 Hail Marys, using quotations from scriptures (which at that time followed the name Jesus, before the end of the Roman intercessory: was added during devotion 15 [27] From the 16th to the 20th century, the structure of the Rosary remained substantially unchanged. [22] There were 15 mysteries, one for each of the 15 decades. During the 20th century, the addition of Fatima prayer at the end of each decade became more common. There were no other changes until 2002, when John Paul II established five new Mysteries of Luminous Optional, although the variations of these had already been proposed by Louis de Montfort and Georgette Preca and were implemented during the mid-20th century by figures like Patrick Peyton. During the 16th century, Pope Pius V associated the rosary with the Roman General Calendar establishingFeast of Our Lady of Victory (later changed with the Madonna del Rosario), which is celebrated on 7 October. Pope Leo XIII, known as "the Rosario Pope", released twelve encyclicals and five apostolic letters concerning the à €

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
