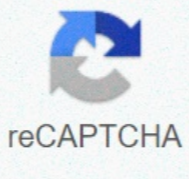

The use of a liquid formula like water and vinegar is a great choice because they are delicate liquids that do not negatively affect the integrity of the screen. Some cleaning solutions may permanently damage the screen protective coatings. When applying cleaning solutions, you need to avoid spraying directly on the screen because that liquid can easily run the screen and leaks in the frames and damage the internal wiring of the TV. This could permanently damage the TV, so the best way to apply cleaning solutions is to wet the fabric you are using directly.
