The concept is similar to a heads of agreement, term sheet or memorandum of understanding. Such outlined agreements may be merger and acquisition transaction agreements.[1] joint venture agreements, real property lease agreements and several other categories of agreements that may govern material transactions. LOIs resemble short, written contracts, but are usually in tabular form and not binding on the parties in their entirety. Many LOIs, however, contain provisions that are binding, such as those governing non-disclosure, governing law, exclusivity or covenants to negotiate in good faith.[1] An LOI may sometimes be interpreted by a court of law as binding the parties to it if it too-closely resembles a formal contract and does not contain clear disclaimers.[2] A letter of intent may be presented by one party to another party and subsequently negotiated before execution (or signature). If carefully negotiated, an LOI may serve to protect both parties to a transaction. For example, a seller of a business may incorporate what is known as a non-solicitation provision, which would restrict the buyer's ability to hire an employee of the seller's business should the two parties not be able to close the transaction. On the other hand, an LOI may protect the buyer of a business by expressly conditioning its obligation to complete the transaction if it is unable to secure financing for the transaction.[3] Purposes of an LOI Common purposes of an LOI are: To allow parties to sketch out fundamental terms quickly before expending substantial resources on negotiating definitive agreements, finalizing due diligence, pursuing third-party approvals and other matters[1] To declare officially that the parties are currently negotiating, as in a merger or joint venture proposal To provide safeguards in case a deal collapses during negotiation To verify certain issues regarding payments made for someone else (e.g., credit card payments) Potential downsides to using an LOI may include: The parties may engage in protracted negotiations on only a subset of a deal's terms Management time and focus may be diverted Alternative opportunities may be missed and markets may move against the parties during negotiations Parties may reduce their lack of a workable deal framework into an LOI, with a hope of making progress later Public disclosure obligations may be inadvertently triggered The risk of leaks, exacerbated by the desire of some to tout the LOI to the world, or shop it to other parties[1] Specific examples See also: National Letter of Intent In academia, a letter of intent is part of the application process.[clarification needed] in which it is also known as a statement of purpose or application essay. In education in the United States, letters of intent are also frequently reached between high school senior athletes and colleges/universities, for the reservation of athletic scholarships for the athletes upon graduation from high school. School administrators in secondary education often require a letter of intent before approving the formation of a student club. In real estate, in cases where the real property in question is not listed on a multiple listing service, there may not be an easy way to notify the owner of the property and other interested parties of intent to purchase. Often it is necessary to officially begin the process of a purchase, and allow all peripheral interested parties to begin any other processes, with a letter of intent. For example, a multimillion-dollar loan for a commercial property may require a letter of intent before a financial institution will allow personnel to spend time working on said loan necessary for the completion of the sale. The same may be followed at the time of purchase by any company. A tenant and landlord may sign a letter of intent prior to signing a lease agreement to stipulate rental rates and all regulations of the future tenancy.[citation needed] In the solicitation of government grants, a letter of intent is highly encouraged but it is not required or binding, and does not enter into the review of a subsequent application. A complaint letter is part of written communication. In a general word, a complaint letter means a letter which is written to submit a complaint to the authority. And it is generally done when another way of the complaint is a failure like a phone, email, etc. However, here we provide a complaint letter definition in a formal way. Complaint Letter Definition A Complaint letter is a request for an adjustment. In other words, it is a letter that describes the damage; errors, or mistakes that happened to the delivered goods and therefore claims for compensation are known to be a complaint letter. In the modern age, the chain of business is not limited to the boundary of the country. As business is expanding, its complexities are also increasing. So, mistake or fault is not a strange matter in the arena of business. There may be a wrong delivery of goods shipment of obsolete, poor quality or underweight goods, faulty packing, delivery after the specified date, and other damages to the goods shipped. In the above cases, a buyer is supposed to suffer financial loss and therefore he has every reason to complain to the seller demanding compensation. Hence a letter is used to serve such purpose is called a complaint letter. To draft such a letter, the buyer must have valid grounds to explain that he has suffered financial loss or otherwise there will be misunderstanding which may damage business relation buyers requires special care with the art of convincing the seller. Clarity and courtesy are important factors to write a letter of complaint. The complaint should be made politely without showing any sign of anger. Causes of Drafting Complaint Letter or, Sources of Mistakes giving rise to Complaints The following are usual causes for which a complaint letter is drafted: 1. Problem with the delivered goods: If the goods that are delivered are - Underweight, Obsolete, Defective, Incomplete, Not according to buyer's specifications such as color, brand, size, etc. Wrong or poor quality, then a buyer can make a claim to the seller for the mistake. 2.Pricing: If there is any mistake in preparing the invoice for the shipped goods, then such a letter is written. 3. Packing: Faulty or poor packing of the goods causes damage to the goods which can be claimed by the seller. 4. Transport: Goods are supposed to be shipped according to the convenience of the buyer. But if the wrong carrier is used it may call for writing such a letter. 5. Terms & Condition: If the terms and conditions of business are violated by the seller then such a letter is placed. 6. Faulty Insurance: If insurance coverage is not made properly according to an instruction of the buyer, then there may be a claim through a complaint letter. On the above grounds, a buyer can complain but it must be in a decent and polite way.
