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## Recommendation letter for postdoctoral position sample

If you are writing a letter of recommendation for a scholarship, work, internship or entry to the specialization school, a letter of recommendation must achieve different purposes. It must give the recipient the confidence that the person for whom the letter is written has the necessary experience and the ability to do well the job, is worthy of admission to a college or is worthy of receiving a prize. The specific information included in a letter of academic recommendation or work is usually different, however. (See reference 1.) When you write a letter of recommendation for an employer, include information about the previous post of the person in the company, responsibility and work skills (loyalty, reliability, ability to work independently and on a team, for example). (See reference 1.) It also includes when the person worked with the company and any professional award or recognition he received. Academic letters of recommendation often must be sent directly to the Admission or Review Board. The confidentiality of the letter is usually required. When you write the letter, think about your experience of having the person as a student. Ask the student for a copy of his personal statement and take it back if he wrote them for his question, and ask him to let you know what his aspirations are, what he received awards and other information about his question. (See reference 2.) Include information about his academic performance, his integrity and dedication to his work and his ability to work alone and with others. Another option is to ask the student to write the letter in person and then review and sign. In the statement of introduction of your letter that you are an adviser, mention your professional position and explain how you are connected to the applicant. Say how long you know the applicant.also a summary of your general feelings about the applicant. You could write, for example: "I am Dr. Sam Smith, professor of Archaeology at XYZ University inMaryland. I am writing a recommendation letter for Bob Harrison, one of my most talented and impressive students for the last two years for the Youth Scholarship Award." (See reference 1.) Also include information on how to compare this student to others. You might say that you have worked a number of years as a professor and taught a specific number of students. (See reference 2.) The organ of your letter should have separate paragraphs for each quality of the applicant. Write specific examples of how you saw the person demonstrate skill or quality. You could write, for example, when talking about the quality of persistence in a candidate: "Bob came to all my tutoring sessions to make sure he fully understood all the lessons, and he managed to earn an A, one of the only five people in his class of 40 to do so." Write only two or three paragraphs for this section. (See reference 1.) Include a statement of light criticism that also includes a force. For example, you could write: "Bob is sometimes too persistent, and sometimes comes as stubbornness. However, he is usually calm and cheerful in his work." (See reference 2.) If you know the activities outside of work or school where the person was involved, include that information in the body of your letter. (See reference 3.) Meets the qualifications of the person and add other comments you feel should be included in the letter. Declare that you believe that the applicant is worthy of the scholarship or admission, or is the right person for work. Provide contact information and sign the letter. (See reference 1.)
