There are several apps that claim to be able to show your Wi-Fi passwords on the game store, but the only one we have found working on all our devices has been wifi password viewer of simonedev. play store link: wifi Password Viewer (free) When you start the first time Wifi Password Viewer, the app will take the Superuser Access. Tap "Grant" on the popup, so you will be brought to a list containing all Wi-Fi networks you've ever connected to, where each item shows a password below. If you are connected to many different Wi-Fi networks during your Android device, your list may be quite long. If this is the case, you can search for a particular Wi-Fi network using the search button in the upper right corner. If you need to share one of these passwords with another device, you have some options. Start by tapping any entry in the list, then a small menu will be displayed. From here, you can tap "copy password" to copy the password of that network to the clipboard, which would make it easy to paste into your favorite text app Send to the other device. Or, you can skip a step and touch "Share", then select your favorite text app from the menu that seems to send the password. Finally, you can also touch "QR" to make the app generate a QR code containing network information.
