In the upper left, select the three-line cell icon Click the little plus sign in the top right corner and select "Automatic" under "Section A". Go to the little plus icon in the top right corner, set the bar number in "Part A" to "Auto" and click "Done". Turn off the clock generator at the top next to the red record button. Use the loop button in the top right to select the song you want from your iPhone. The ringtone has a maximum length of 30 seconds. You should take this into account. Use small scissors to cut the sound clip by dragging it down with your finger for a while. This will erase the unused parts of the song. Click the little arrow in the top right corner and select "My Songs". Tap on "Select" on the right and mark the ringtone. Now click on the circle with three dots in the upper right corner and hit "Select". Select your ringtone with one tap to reveal a blue check mark, then tap the share icon in the lower left. Press "Ringtone" and select "Default ringtone" or "Assign contact" Then simply set the ringtone in the "Settings" app under "Sounds & Haptics" as the new ringtone. Now, some phones have good file managers on them out of the box, but if not, you'll need to download one from the Google Play Store; for our steps, we're using Solid Explorer. Long-press your custom ringtone in the Downloads folder (or whichever local folder you downloaded it to). After long-pressing the first ringtone, you can tap more ringtones if you wish to copy multiple sounds at once. Tap the Copy icon ( two documents stacked on top of each other). Swipe in from the left edge of the screen to open the location menu. If you're using Android 10 gestures, turn your phone horizontal to get two tabs, the left window will be your source folder, and the right folder you can navigate to the Ringtones folder.)
